Thank you for your letter dated 14 June 2015 which we received through PC Steve Blandford on 18 June.

We can only imagine the suffering experienced by the Nepalese community caused by the recent earthquakes. We hope you received our message to you through [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at the Safety Advisory Group meeting on 1 May 2015 in which we said:

“Following the terrible earthquake in Nepal in which so many people have died and are suffering, the International Shugden Community would like to offer our heartfelt condolences to everyone who has lost friends and relatives and who is suffering great hardship in this terrible disaster. We are praying for all those who have died and are suffering.”

Since the time of the earthquakes, many members of the International Shugden Community (ISC) have made continual prayers, and some have donated money, for the benefit of those affected. Of course we are happy to respect your prayers of remembrance and moments of silence for the victims of the earthquakes. During that portion of the Dalai Lama’s visit to your Centre we will suspend our chanting.


We would like to ask you to also have compassion for Shugden Buddhists who have been suffering greatly for 20 years due to Dalai Lama’s ban on an essential spiritual practice given to them by their Lineage Gurus.

Imagine how you would feel if, simply due to your faith, you were discriminated against and ostracized in Aldershot. Imagine how Nepalese Buddhists would feel if they were banned from holding government positions, not allowed to be doctors or nurses,

The only way to solve this problem is for the Dalai Lama to change himself. Please use your beneficial influence to help the Dalai Lama to change himself by accepting these four points. If he does this before the event, then we will cancel our demonstration. Otherwise, we will carry out our demonstration against the Dalai Lama as planned.

We would really appreciate your compassion for Shugden Buddhists and your understanding for the importance of protecting pure Buddhism in this world.
